Purpose of the event

- Offer updated information on EGNSS, successful applications, technologies and markets
- Create a follow-up opportunity in networking and industry liaison, taking stock from previous GNSS.asia events as well as the first EU-Japan Partnering Support Mission on the space sector
- Meet European companies in the area of GNSS and interested in working with Japanese partners
- Discuss cooperation opportunities in EU-Japan GNSS downstream at business and R&D level (Horizon2020)
- In the afternoon the same building will host from 15h00 to 17h15 the **annual SPAC FORUM with ~400 participants** from Japanese public authorities, company representatives and experts in GNSS and related areas. The event will be followed by a networking reception at 17h30. Interpretation is provided

Workshop Content

After the successful launch of two more Galileo Satellites in March 2015 the launch schedule is catching up. Initial Galileo services are planned to start by 2016 and full operation will be in 2020. Also the latest space policy plan in Japan (January 2015) communicated the go ahead to build QZSS to 7 satellites, in order to offer sustainable positioning and augmentation services. The Japanese government is targeting completion in 2023.

According to the GNSS Market Report published in March 2015, the market of 3.6 bln GNSS LBS devices (2014) will grow to over 7 bln by 2019. Asia is seeing the largest area of growth and is in the hotspot of developments.

A speaker from GSA will provide updates on Galileo satellites and its services. Furthermore we are going to talk about the opportunities for EU-Japan Cooperation in the GNSS market from an industrial perspective.

The target audience for this event will be business based and operating in the Japanese market academia and stakeholders interested in cooperation with the EU on GNSS user segment.
