Support Projects: 2. NCP for Horizon 2020 in Japan

- National Contact Point for Horizon 2020 in Japan. Local project funded by the Japanese government (METI/MOFA). The EU-Japan Centre started April 2014.
- NCP system goal: provide guidance, practical information and assistance on all aspects of participation in Horizon 2020
- Activities include helpdesk services, information seminars, translation of important H2020 related documents in Japanese and trainings
- Collaboration with Enterprise Europe Network (EEN) and the JEUIPSTE project

Services by JEUIPSTE/NCP

- A **help desk** for any inquiry related to Horizon 2020
- Actively helping Japanese organizations to participate in Horizon 2020 by providing them **with tailored information** and **practical information on administrative issues** that might arise
- Providing a **website in Japanese** with easily accessible information on Horizon 2020 and how to participate
- Providing **Japanese translations of key documents** in Horizon 2020 (such as the Grant Agreement) for easier access to Japanese organisations
- Providing **trainings** for research administrators and managers to deal with EU research projects
- Organising **events for networking/twinning** in specific areas
- Partner search support

Examples of inquiries Horizon 2020 help desk

Inquiry 1: Guidance on choosing relevant H2020 topics and actions

A company is investigating whether to participate, but would like to understand better how their company can be involved and what type of action is most appropriate, e.g. innovation action or research and innovation action

→ we can provide tailored information (work programme, application process, project examples) and give guidance to which parts of the Horizon 2020 programme are most appropriate

Inquiry 2: Advice on administrative procedures and contractual issues

An organization is part of a consortium that is submitting a proposal and has to register a Participant Identification Code (PIC), but encounters problems in the registration process

→ we can give advice on the administrative procedures and if necessary contact the relevant services in European Commission to identify the problems and solutions
